The administrative parish of Nurmijärvi was founded in 1775. Hyvinkää seceded from the municipality in 1917.

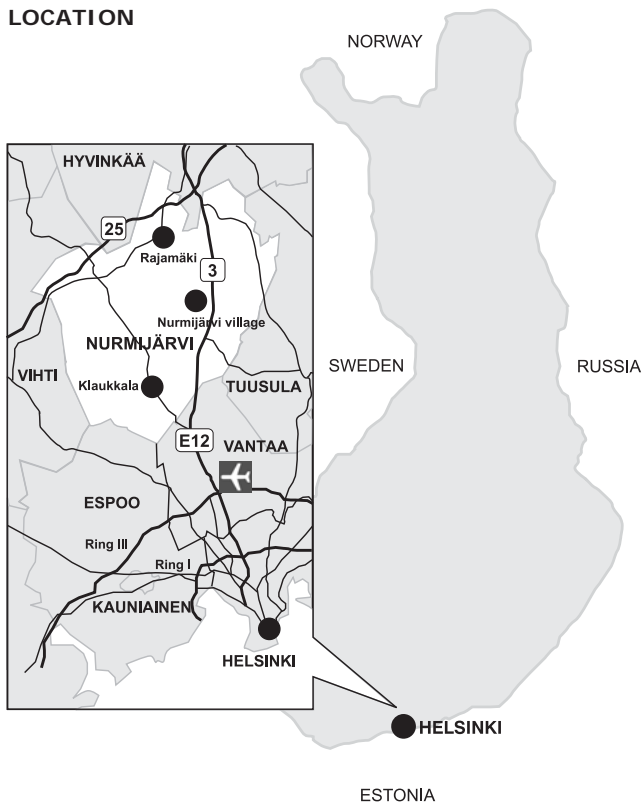

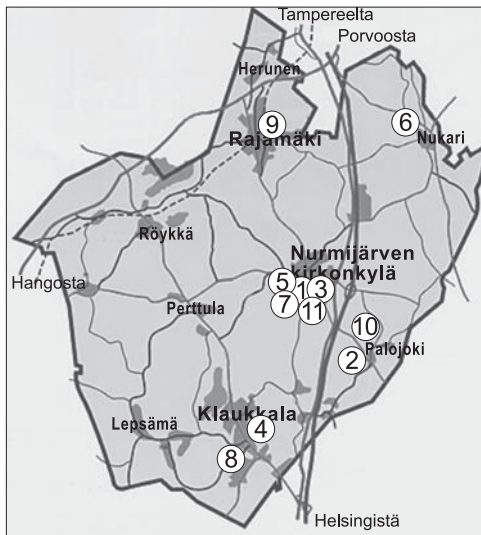

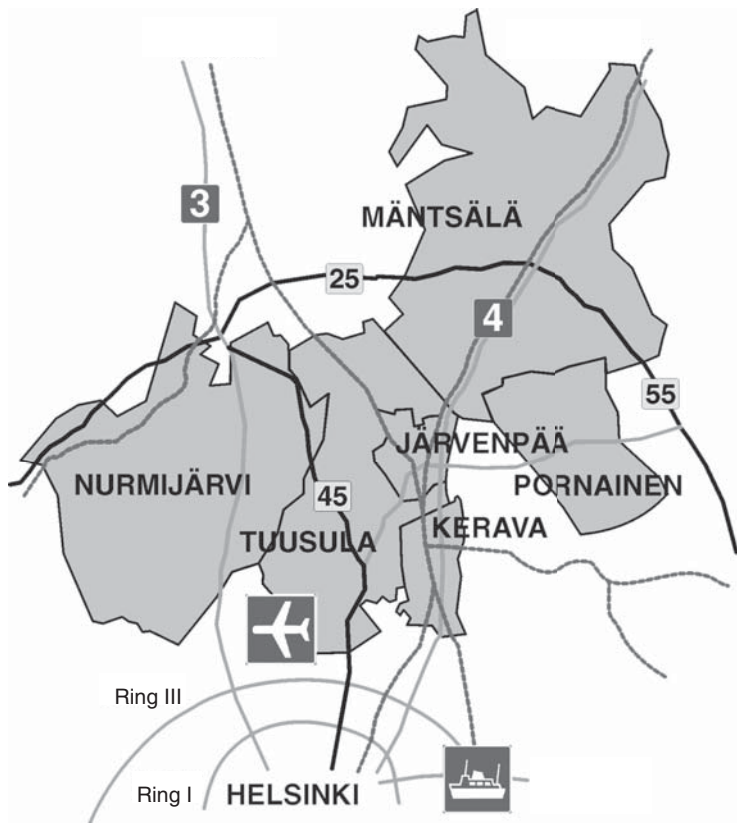
